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# JINKIES!

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“My needles! I can’t knit without my needles!” The season’s hottest newly-out LGBT icon on everyone’s lips is Miss Velma Dinkley. Along with her iconic glasses and pleated skirt, her legendary look isn’t complete without her bright orange turtleneck sweater. Sized in a 56” chest, with an easily tailorable pattern, this top-down raglan is the perfect pullover to help solve mysteries with Scooby and the gang!

## Skills Used

Knitting in-the-round

Separating Sleeves

Picking Up Stitches

Increasing/Decreasing

## Finished Measurements

## Materials and Tools

Sample uses 8 Skein of Red Heart Super Saver in color Pumpkin

Yarn needle

24” Circular Knitting Needles- Size 15 (10.00 mm)

(Optional) Double Pointed Needles- Size 15 (10.00 mm)

4 stitch markers

## Blocked Gauge

10 stitches by 14 rows = 4”/ 10 cm unstretched in stockinette

## Notes

Pattern uses two strands of yarn held together throughout.

## Stitch Guide

K- Knit

P- Purl

M1R- Make One Right

M1L- Make One Left

K2Tog- Knit Two Together

BO- Bind Off

CO- Cast On

St/Sts- Stitch/Stitches



## ***Instructions***

Cast on 88 Sts

**Round 1-20:** (K2, p2) to end of round.

**Round 21:** K16, pm, k12, pm, k32, pm, k12, pm k16.

**Round 22:** (K to 1 st before next marker, m1r, k1, sm, k1, m1l) four times, k to end of row. — 96 stitches on needles

**Round 23:** K all sts.

**Rounds 24-51:** Repeat rounds 22, 23. — End with 208 stitches on needles

**Separation Round:** Removing markers as you go, K31, place next 42 sts on waste yarn, cast on 8 sts using short-tail cast-on method, k62, place next 42 sts on second waste yarn, cast on 8 sts using short-tail cast-on method, k31. — 140 stitches on needles.

## ***Body***

**Rounds 1-30:** K all sts.

**Rounds 31-35:** (K2, p2) to end of round.

***Bind off and weave in ends.***

## ***Sleeves (Make 2)***

Place live sts from waste yarn onto dpns. With the new yarn and working needle, pick up 8 sts evenly from 8 sts cast-on under the armhole. — 50 stitches on needles.

**Rounds 1-49:** K all sts.



**Round 50:** (K2tog) 25 times — 25 stitches on needles

**Round 51:** K2tog, k1, (p2, k2) five times, p2. — 24 stitches on needles

**Rounds 52-80:** (K2, p2) to end of round.


***Bind off and weave in ends.***

## ***Finishing***

Block the garment to the finished measurements.

### *Measurements*

Chest Circumference A: 56"

Body Length B: 8½"

Turtleneck Length C: 5¾"

Neck Circumference D: 35½"

Sleeve Length E: 22¾"

Armhole Circumference F: 20"

Wrist Circumference G: 9½"
