## Skills Used

- Knit
- Purl
- Cabling
- Decreasing

## Finished Measurements

**Finished Height:** 7.5" Blocked (on vase)

**Finished Circumference:** 15" Blocked

## Materials and Tools

- Sample uses Worsted Weight Nonsuperwash Wool (100% Wool; 100 g = 220 yds): 1 skein
- Cable Needle
- 16" circulars and DPNs in size US 7 (4.5 mm) or size to obtain gauge
- Can measuring approximately 7.5" high and 15" in circumference ( I used a clean large metal pineapple juice can)
- Stitch marker to mark the beginning of round

## Gauge

Cable Pattern:

26 sts by 25 rounds = 4" Blocked

## Stitch Guide

**K**- Knit

**P**- Purl

**K2Tog**- Knit two together

**SSK**- Slip Slip Knit (Slip the next two stitches knitwise, then knit these two slipped stitches together through the back loops.)

**C6F**- Cable 6 Front (Slip 3 knit stitches to cable stitch holder and hold in front of work, k3 from left hand needle, k3 from cable stitch holder.)

**C6B**- Cable 6 Back (Slip 3 knit stitches to cable stitch holder and hold in back of work, k3 from left hand needle, k3 from cable stitch holder.)

**Sts**- Stitches

## Pattern

*Cast on 96 sts using long tail method.*

**Rounds 1-20:** (K2, p2) 24 times.

**Rounds 21, 22:** K all sts.

**Round 23:** (C6f, k2) 12 times.

**Rounds 24, 25:** K all sts.

**Round 26:** (K2, c6b) 12 times.

**Rounds 27-68:** Repeat rows 21-26 seven times

**Round 69:** P all sts.

**Round 70:** (K10, k2tog) eight times.-88 sts

**Round 71:** P all sts.

**Round 72:** (K2, k2tog) 22 times.-66 sts

**Round 73:** P all sts.

**Round 74:** (K1, k2tog) 22 times.-44 sts

**Round 75:** P all sts.

**Round 76:** K2tog 22 times.-22 sts

**Round 77:** P all sts.

**Round 78:** K2tog 11 times.-11 sts

**Round 79:** P all sts.

**Round 80:** K all sts.

*Fasten off, weave in ends*
